Family Concessions

A **sibling concession** on tuition fees applies for students attending Concordia Campus and/or St John's Campus (excluding ELC) at the same time.

- 2nd child in family 10% of tuition fee
- 3rd child in family 20% of tuition fee

Composite Fee

This fee covers most curriculum requirements including use of textbooks, school magazine, project materials, co-curricular activities, cost of year level camps and most excursions. Payment is required for part of the cost of other camps.

At St John's Campus payment is required for the cost of voluntary extra-curricular activities, eg. school sport, music tuition, Have-a-Go programs.

IT Levy

This fee includes the provision of a fully-serviced device, software and campus web access for the school year.

IB Diploma Fee

This fee applies to students enrolled in the Year 11 & 12 IB Diploma Programme to cover costs associated with the delivery of this curriculum such as registration, examination and moderation.

Building Fund

The College has a Building Fund to which parents may make voluntary, tax deductible contributions. It is requested that each family contributes \$600 per year (\$150 per term). The support of the Building Fund is essential for the continuing refurbishment and development of the College buildings.

Payment of Fees

Fees may be paid by the following methods:

1. Annually in advance, by 30 November of the preceding year, with a discount of 2.5% on tuition fees.
2. Four instalments, by 30 November of the preceding year, 28 February, 31 May and 31 August.
3. By regular direct debit or credit card instalments, by arrangement with the Finance Manager.

Accounts are rendered early in the month in which payment is due.

The Concordia College Board reserves the right to terminate the schooling of a student whose fees are in arrears. The College also reserves the right to charge a late payment fee and the cost of recovery fees on overdue accounts.

When a student is to be withdrawn from the school, parents are required to give the Principal one school term's notice, in writing, before the withdrawal date, otherwise parents will be liable for an additional term's fees.

Stationery

Stationery packs are purchased by families directly from the School's external supplier. The School will provide information to families regarding this.

Transport Fee

This fee is applicable to students travelling on College buses.

Concordia Old Collegians Association Membership Fee

A fee of \$150 per student for membership to the Concordia Old Collegians Association (COCA) will be invoiced on the first fee account. This membership fee provides a lifetime membership to COCA upon leaving the College at any year level.

Concordia Parents and Friends (Years 7-12)

Included on the account is a charge of \$50 per family per year for membership of Concordia Campus Parents and Friends. Membership is encouraged to further the activities and fundraising of this key support group of the College.

Early Learning Centre (ELC)

The ELC is approved as a Long Day Care Provider.

Families can access both the Child Care Rebate (non-means tested, but both parents must be working, training or studying) and the Child Care Benefit (means tested).

The ELC is open for 48 weeks a year however attendance during the school holidays is optional.

Accounts will be issued at the beginning of each term based on enrolment and include permanent Extended Care bookings.

Fees for casual Extended Care bookings are added to the following term's account.

OSHC is approved as an OSHC provider.

Families can access both the Child Care Rebate (non-means tested, but both parents must be working, training or studying) and the Child Care Benefit (means tested). Accounts will be issued fortnightly by email and are based on enrolment/attendance detail.

- Permanent Booking is considered as any booking made prior to close of business (6pm) on the Friday of the preceding week of booking.
- Casual Booking is any booking made during the week of the required booking.
- A 24 hour cancellation period will apply to all permanent bookings – all permanent bookings not cancelled prior to close of business the previous day will be charged as normal.
- Late fee of \$1 per minute for the first 10 minutes and \$5 per minute thereafter will apply after 6.00pm.
- Enrolment Fee of \$20 per child upon their enrolment into OSHC. This fee will cover the child for their entire primary school life.
