Music Scholarships 2018

Music scholarships will be offered to new or current students in Years 7 to 12, in 2018.

The scholarships provide partial or full remission of tuition fees, with instrumental bursaries available, at the discretion of the Principal to the end of Year 12 at Concordia College.

Successful candidates will be expected to make a significant contribution to a minimum of two co-curricular music groups on their auditioned instrument(s) and other music activities as determined by the Director of Music. Successful candidates will also be expected to undertake Music as a subject from Years 9 to 12.

Scholarships will be reviewed annually and are dependent on satisfactory progress reports, conduct and commitment to the co-curricular music program.

Criteria for Award

- > Candidates will have displayed outstanding ability or potential on their instruments and have a proven academic record.
- > It is understood that successful candidates will complete their secondary schooling at Concordia College.
- > The student will not be in receipt of any other financial support from Concordia College.

Application Procedure

Application for this scholarship must be made by completing and returning the attached application form to Concordia College, 24 Winchester Street Highgate SA 5063, marked attention *Scholarship Committee* together with:

- > A copy of your latest school report and music certificates
- > Any other relevant supporting information

A short-list of candidates will be invited to audition in February 2017. Auditions will take approximately 30 minutes and candidates will be required to:

- > perform two pieces of contrasting character
- > perform scales and exercises
- > undertake sight reading and aural tests
- > present for an interview

Students will be required to provide their own accompanist. Parents are encouraged to attend the interview. Auditions will be held in the Music Centre at Concordia College. Please indicate on the return form any times when you are unavailable for an audition.
