# General Excellence Scholarship 2018

One scholarship is available each year to a new student commencing in Years 7 to 12 who displays outstanding characteristics across a broad range of areas including high academic achievement. Year 7 students at Concordia College in 2017 are eligible to apply. This scholarship provides part remission of tuition fees for up to six years.

The successful applicant will be a student who has displayed qualities of selflessness, service, leadership, and commitment within their school and wider community.

This scholarship provides part remission of tuition fees for the duration of the student's schooling at Concordia for a maximum of six years, until the completion of Year 12. Continuation of the scholarship is subject to regular review, with the recipient making good academic progress, contributing to the College in a variety of ways and displaying conduct of a high standard.

## Criteria for Award

- > Consistently high academic performance in most subjects.
- > Active involvement in co-curricular activities which may include, but are not limited to, sport, debating, or music.
- > Leadership roles within the current school or wider community.
- > Outstanding personal qualities.
- > Involvement in Community Service.
- > Positive contribution to the current school community in a variety of ways.
- > Financial circumstances may also be taken into consideration.
- > The student will not be in receipt of any other financial support from Concordia College.
- > Applicants may be required to sit an examination and short-listed applicants will be required to attend an interview with the Principal.

## Application Process

Applications for this scholarship must be made by completing and returning the attached application form to Concordia College, 24 Winchester Street Highgate SA 5063, marked attention *Scholarship Committee*, together with:

- > a written statement from the student outlining their past achievements and future goals
- > school reports from previous two years
- > NAPLAN reports
- > copies of academic certificates of achievement
- > copies of sporting, music or other certificates of achievement
- > references from the current school Principal, teachers, coaches or mentors.
