Term 2 2021 - COVID-19 Update

As a whole College ELC to Year 12, we continue to monitor advice from SA Health regarding COVID-19. Concordia College remains vigilant adhering to guidelines. The recent outbreak of COVID-19 in Victoria demonstrates why we must all remain vigilant at all times.

Here are the current guidelines that we will follow until further notice. We will advise of any changes should the need arise, in a timely manner. Thank you for your assistance and understanding.

We cannot be complacent. We thank you for assisting us to maintain measures. What the College continues to do:

- Regular cleaning of high touch areas during the day
- Provide sanitiser in all areas
- Ensure that soap dispensers are functioning and have soap
- Remind students to thoroughly wash hands
- Send unwell students to appropriate personnel for assessment and appropriate follow up action
- Limit the number of adults in any one space (75% capacity)
- Self-declaration and recording names and phone numbers of all visitors to the College
- AHPPC believes that adults in the school environment should practice room density measures given the greater risk of transmission between adults.
- Families and employees are asked to maintain physical distancing from other parents and teachers if attending school, including when dropping off and picking up children.
- ELC-Year 6: Parents/caregivers (1 adult per child) may enter the College to bring students to their classroom before and after school. We ask you to ensure a timely arrival and leaving of no more than 10 minutes - ensure you check-in using the QR code and maintain social distancing. Alternatively, masks must be worn by adults.
- QR codes are available at main entrances and we implore all adults to please check-in.

Urgent testing reminder:

- For anyone who has been in **Greater Melbourne on or after 20 May** and entered South Australia before 6.00pm 26 May must obtain a COVID-19 test and quarantine until you receive a negative result. You must also get tested on Day 5 and day 13 but you are not required to quarantine after receiving a negative result.
- Anyone with symptoms (fever, cough, fatigue, sore throat, runny nose, shortness of breath or loss of taste or smell) should get tested for COVID-19, even if symptoms are mild and can return to College following a negative result and symptoms have subsided.
