Spotlight on an Old Concordian

Jonathan Koch, Class of 1999



In November, we heard from Jonathan who is an offshore oil and gas drilling engineer with Shell. Jonathan lives in Brisbane, for and wide

but his work takes him far and wide - including to some very remote places! He is currently stationed in the Persian Gulf on the Iranian border with Qatar where he leads an exploration drilling rig in the middle of the Gulf and is one of the few still travelling internationally. It is a very challenging and dangerous environment, especially with the concerns of COVID-19. Jonathan values the support of others to maintain a connection to home and is very glad to say that it is often the strong relationships formed at Concordia that continue to this day to help him through.

What are some defining memories of your time at Concordia?

As an adult reflecting on my time at the College I have a much greater awareness that for many of my teachers, their role as Christian educators was very much their calling in life as opposed to purely a teaching profession, which is a special distinction worthy of note. I have countless fond memories of individuals such as Peter Leske, Peter Schmidt, Beryl Solly and Mark Schubert, to name a few, going the extra mile to provide an encouraging environment for students to learn academically and to develop as unique individuals.

What advice would you offer current students?

Make the most of your time at the College and recognise the value of the relationships you have with those with whom you are sharing the experience. Your time at Concordia College is but a short time in your life; however, the bonds you build with each other will serve as a strong base for you to then branch out and explore the world.
