General Excellence Scholarships 2023

Two scholarships are available to new or continuing students commencing in Years 7 to 12 who display outstanding characteristics across a broad range of areas, including high academic achievement. The successful applicants will demonstrate qualities of leadership, service and commitment within their school and wider community.

This scholarship provides 50% remission of tuition fees for up to six years, depending on year of entry. Continuation of the scholarship is subject to review, with the recipient making good academic progress, contributing to the College in a variety of ways and displaying conduct of a high standard.

Criteria for Award

This scholarship is awarded based on the criteria below:

- + Consistently high academic performance in most subjects
- + Active involvement in co-curricular activities, which may include, but are not limited to, sport, debating, or music
- + Leadership roles within the current school or wider community
- + Outstanding personal qualities
- + Involvement in Community Service
- + Positive contribution to the current school community in a variety of ways
- + Financial circumstances may also be taken into consideration
- + The student will not be in receipt of any other financial support from Concordia College
- + Short-listed applicants will be required to attend an interview with the Principal

Application Process

Applications must be made online at www.concordia.sa.edu.au/enrolment/scholarships

To be considered for a scholarship, please ensure the following documents are supplied as part of the online application process:

- + Copies of the student's school reports for 2021
- + Copies of the student's NAPLAN reports
- + A cover letter outlining the student's past achievements and future goals, and reasons for selecting the Concordia General Excellence Scholarship
- + A list of academic awards or certificates of achievement (copies may be required if shortlisted)
- + A list of awards or achievements in sport, music, debating, leadership, community service and other areas relevant to your application (copies of awards / certificates of achievement may be required if shortlisted)
- + Details of two referees, which may include the current school Principal, teachers, coaches or mentors

All details will remain confidential to the Concordia Scholarship Committee
