

Boys Uniform

The Summer Uniform is worn during Term 1 and Term 4. The Winter Uniform is worn during Term 2 and Term 3. There is a changeover period of two weeks at the start of Term 2 and the end of Term 3. This means that if the weather is warmer the students are able to wear their Summer Uniform.

Summer Uniform

Shirt – short sleeve banded open-neck blue/white fine pinstripe with College crest.

Shorts – navy shorts.

Jumper – navy with College crest.

Socks – white CC sport/summer.

Hat – navy sunsmart bucket with College crest.

Shoes – need to be a black leather lace up school shoe with stepped heel in good condition. Younger students may choose to wear black leather school shoes with a Velcro strap.

Navy blue sandals are optional, must be worn without socks.

Winter Uniform

Shirt – long sleeve banded blue/white fine pinstripe.

Jumper – navy with College crest.

Trousers/Shorts – grey double knee trousers or grey pleated shorts.

Socks – long navy (gold/blue stripe) cotton blend.

Tie – Concordia elastic slip-on.

Shoes – need to be a black leather lace up school shoe with stepped heel in good condition. Younger students may choose to wear black leather school shoes with a Velcro strap.

Additional Expectations

Hair – should be neatly styled. Long hair, on or below the shoulder must be tied back at all times. Extreme artificial hair colouring and styling is not acceptable. Hair should not draw specific/undue attention to a student. Shortest acceptable hair length is a 'No 2 cut' all over.

School Bags – College badged bags (Reception to Year 6).

Formal Occasions

The items to be worn for occasions such as class photographs and the Closing Service are as follows: Term 1 & 4 Boys' Summer Uniform. Terms 2 & 3 Boys' Winter Uniform.

PE Uniform

Boys & Girls

Shorts – navy with College CC.

Track Pants – navy with College CC.

Polo Shirt – navy with gold and white stripes and College crest short sleeves or long sleeves (optional).

Rugby Top – navy with gold and white stripes and College crest.

Track Jacket – optional, can be worn over the rugby top. During Terms 2 & 3 may be worn over the winter uniform jumper.

Shoes – need to provide appropriate support and protection for PE lessons and school sports. The best options are cross trainers or joggers. Younger students may choose to have Velcro straps rather than laces.

(*'Skate shoes', 'volleys', 'slip on' sneakers or similar styles of casual footwear are not acceptable*).

Socks – white CC sport/summer.

Hat – navy sunsmart bucket.

All students wear their PE Uniform to school on the days they have PE.

St John's Campus

Students in R – Year 3

Students may wear their PE Uniform to school on the days that they have training for their team or Have-a-Go programmes.

Students in Years 4 – 6

An additional day will be chosen by the year level teachers for fitness activities. Students are also required to wear their uniform on this day.

Students may wear PE Uniform during the school day if they have training after school for a Concordia sports team. Students are to wear their formal uniform on all other days.

St John's Church Netball

Uniforms – No part of this uniform is to be worn at Concordia College.

St Peters Campus

Students in R – Year 2

PE uniform; Optional formal uniform on non-PE day.

Students in Years 3 – 6

Formal uniform, PE on allocated sport day.

Girls Uniform

The Summer Uniform is worn during Term 1 and Term 4. The Winter Uniform is worn during Term 2 and Term 3. There is a changeover period of two weeks at the start of Term 2 and the end of Term 3. This means that if the weather is warmer the students are able to wear their Summer Uniform.

Summer Uniform

Dress – College navy check with navy trim.

Shirt – white short sleeve with navy trim and College crest (optional).

Shorts – navy shorts (optional).
Pleated Shorts – navy (optional) (Years 5 and 6 only).

Jumper – navy with College crest.

Hat - navy sunsmart bucket.

Socks – white CC sport/summer.

Shoes – need to be a black leather lace up school shoe with stepped heel in good condition. Younger students may choose to wear black 'Mary Jane' style shoes.

Younger students may choose to wear black 'Mary Jane' style shoes or black leather school shoes with a Velcro strap.

Navy blue sandals are optional, must be worn without socks.

Winter Uniform

Pinafore – College navy check (Bibs may be removed in Year 5).

Skirt – College navy check (worn only from Year 5).

Pants – grey (optional).

Shirt – white long sleeve with Peter Pan collar.

Jumper – navy with College crest.

Tie – College check tie tab.

Tights – navy.

Socks – navy knee high socks.

Shoes – need to be a black leather lace up school shoe with stepped heel in good condition. Younger students may choose to wear black 'Mary Jane' style shoes or black leather school shoes with a Velcro strap.

Additional Expectations

Hair – should be neatly styled. Long hair, on or below the shoulder must be tied back at all times. Extreme artificial hair colouring and styling is not acceptable. Hair should not draw specific/undue attention to a student. Navy, white or gold ribbons may be worn with the uniform. Navy or gold headbands may be worn as well as College fabric scrunchies.

Jewellery – is not permitted except for one plain gold or silver stud/sleeper in each ear. A discreet silver or gold cross on a simple metal chain worn around the neck as an affirmation of personal faith may be worn. Medic alert bracelets worn as required.

Students are not to come to school with **make up or nail polish** that can be seen.

School Bags – College badged bags (Reception to Year 6).

Early Learning Centre

Shorts - navy with zip pocket.

Track Pants - navy fleece with College CC.

Polo Shirt - navy, gold and white with short sleeves.
(navy and gold style permitted until 2023)

Rugby Top - navy, gold and white.

Fleece 1/4 Zip Top - navy with College Crest
(optional).

Track Jacket - can be worn over the rugby top or
fleece top (optional).

Shoes - need to provide appropriate support and
protection for PE. lessons and school sports. The
best options are cross trainers or joggers. 'Skate
shoes', 'volleys', 'slip on' sneakers or similar styles
of casual footwear are not acceptable. Younger
students may choose to have Velcro straps rather

Sandals - navy blue buckle or velcro straps, worn
without socks.

Socks - white socks that cover the ankles. Socks
are not to be worn with sandals (optional white CC
sport/summer).

Hat - navy sunsmart bucket with College CC.

School Bags - Optional for ELC students.
