

Uniform

All students are expected to wear the full Summer Uniform in Terms 1 and 4 and the full Winter Uniform in Terms 2 and 3. With the exception of students in Year 7 and 8, these students are permitted to wear PE uniform to school on the days they have Physical Education. In exceptional circumstances where the full uniform is unwearable on required days, students may be permitted to come to school in their PE Uniform. In this instance, students must have a parent note in their planner providing an acceptable reason for the uniform infringement.

Students are permitted a transition period of TWO weeks to wear the alternative season's uniform if the weather becomes unseasonal and is unexpectedly hot or cold.

Girls Summer

Dress – College check (no shorter than the top of the knee). Grey pants may be worn in summer with a tucked in long-sleeve blouse, belt, tie and grey ribbed socks.

Pleated Shorts – navy (optional).

Blouse – white short sleeve with navy trim and College crest (optional).

Jumper – navy jumper (Years 7-9) grey seniors jumper (Years 10-12), both with College crest.

Shoes – black leather lace up school shoes with stepped heel and black laces (no coloured stitching). Shoes must be polished. Black leather sports, skate or fashion shoe are not acceptable. See example of shoe.

Socks – CC sport/summer socks.

Hat – brimmed straw hat with navy trim.

Girls Winter

Skirt – College check, hem below the knee.

Pants (optional) – to be worn with College belt and grey ribbed socks.

Blouse – white long sleeve, to be worn tucked in.

Tie – navy and gold-stripped.

Jumper – navy jumper (Years 7-9) grey seniors jumper (Years 10-12), both with College crest.

Tights – navy opaque or cotton blend.

Kneehighs – navy opaque

College Blazer – In Terms 2 and 3 the blazer must be worn to and from College and until the end of Chapel worship.

Shoes – black leather lace up school shoes with stepped heel and black laces (no coloured stitching). Shoes must be polished. Black leather sports, skate or fashion shoes are not acceptable. See example of shoe.

Scarf – navy or cream (optional).

Formal Uniform

The items to be worn for occasions such as class photographs, excursions, musical performances and the Valedictory Service are as follows:

Terms 1 & 4: Summer Dress OR Pleated Shorts & short sleeve blouse, with College Blazer, no jumper.

Terms 2 & 3: Winter Skirt OR Pants with long sleeve blouse and tie, College Blazer, no jumper.

Additional Expectations

Hair – should be neatly styled, kept clean and be of a reasonable length. Long hair (on or below the shoulder) must be tied back at all times. Extreme artificial hair colouring and styling is not acceptable. Hair should not draw specific/ undue attention to a student. Navy, white or gold ribbons may be worn with the uniform. Navy, white, gold or uniform fabric headbands/scrunchies may be worn.

Make-up – obvious makeup is not permitted.

Jewellery – one small gold or silver stud (no larger than 5mm) or one small gold or silver sleeper (no larger than 12mm) is permitted to be worn in each earlobe. A discreet silver or gold cross on a simple metal chain worn around the neck as an affirmation of personal faith may be worn. Medic alert bracelets worn as required.



Additional jewellery – not permitted.

School Bag – College badged bag.

Nail polish and artificial nails – are not permitted.

Chewing gum – is not permitted.

Headphones/Earbuds* – are not permitted except at the discretion of the classroom teacher.

Boys Summer

Shorts – navy. The blazer is not to be worn with the navy shorts.

Shirt – white, short-sleeve, non-tuck, with College crest (only to be worn with shorts). OR plain white, long-sleeve (must be worn tucked in with navy and gold-striped tie). Grey trousers may be worn in summer with long-sleeve tucked in shirt and tie.

Belt – College black leather to be worn with long sleeve shirt (optional with short sleeve shirt).

Jumper – navy jumper (Years 7-9) grey seniors jumper (Years 10-12), both with College crest.

Shoes – black leather lace up school shoes with stepped heel and black laces (no coloured stitching). Shoes must be polished. Black

leather sports, skate or fashion shoes are not acceptable. See example of shoe.

Socks – CC sport/summer if wearing shorts. Grey ribbed with trousers.

Hat – brimmed straw hat with navy trim.

Boys Winter

Trousers – grey.

Shirt – plain white long-sleeve.

Belt – College black leather.

Tie – navy and gold-striped.

Jumper – navy jumper (Years 7-9) grey seniors jumper (Years 10-12), both with College crest.

College Blazer – In Terms 2 and 3 the blazer must be worn to and from College and until the end of Chapel worship. The blazer is not to be worn with the navy shorts.

Shoes – black leather lace up school shoes with stepped heel and black laces (no coloured stitching). Shoes must be polished. Black leather sports, skate or fashion shoes are not acceptable.

Socks – CC sport/summer if wearing shorts, grey ribbed with trousers.

Scarf – navy or cream (optional).

Formal Uniform

The items to be worn for occasions such as class photographs, excursions, musical performances and the Valedictory Service, Winter Uniform with blazer no jumper.

Additional Expectations

Hair – should be neatly styled and kept clean. Long hair (on or below the shoulder) must be tied back at all times. Extreme artificial hair colouring and styling is not acceptable. Hair should not draw specific/undue attention to a student. Shortest accepted hair length will be a “No. 2” cut.

Boys are to be clean shaven.

Jewellery – one small gold/silver stud, no larger than 5mm, in each ear-lobe is acceptable. A discreet silver or gold cross on a simple metal chain worn around the neck as an affirmation of personal faith may be worn. Medic alert bracelets worn as required.

Additional jewellery – not permitted.

Long-sleeve shirts – must always be worn tucked in with all buttons fastened.

The tie knot – should be neatly against the collar.

School Bag – College badged bag.

Chewing gum – is not permitted.

Headphones/Earbuds* – Students are not permitted to have or use wireless headphones, including AirPods and other headphones with a Bluetooth connection during the school day or while on excursion. Wired headphones are still permitted to be used with laptops during learning activities, but only at the discretion of teachers.



PE Uniform

Year 7 and 8 students are permitted to wear PE uniform to school on days they have Physical Education. Year 9 to Year 12 students must change into appropriate College PE uniform for practical lessons. Once changed, students have the option of staying in their PE uniform for the remainder of the day or to change back into the appropriate school uniform at recess or lunch.

Shorts Unisex – navy with gold trim.

Girls Shorts – navy with gold trim.

Polo Shirt – navy, gold and white with short sleeves (gold polo shirt is not permissible).

Socks – CC sport/summer.

Track Pants – navy with gold trim.

Track Jacket – navy, gold and white

Rugby Top – navy, gold and white.

Hoodie – navy with gold embroidery.

Hat – navy cap or sunsmart bucket hat.

Sports Duffel Bag – navy with College logo. Other branded bags not permitted.

Sport Shoes – that provide appropriate support and protection are required for PE lessons and school sports.

The best options are cross-trainers or joggers. ‘Skate shoes’, ‘Volleys’, ‘Slip-on’ sneakers or similar styles of casual footwear are NOT acceptable.

Students wearing incorrect sports uniform will not be permitted to represent the College in sport.

PE uniform over-garments cannot be worn with either the Summer or Winter Uniform.

Before school trainings –

If students have sports practice before school, they must change into school uniform before Home Class commences at 8.25am, unless they have a requirement to wear PE uniform at some time during the course of the school day or after school (i.e. PE lesson, sports practice, athletics meet, etc.).

Students who do not have a sports commitment beyond a pre-school practice, and who fail to change into school uniform, will be issued with a uniform notification.

Uniform requirements for specific sports:

ATHLETICS & CROSS

COUNTRY (Inter-school) – gold singlet with blue trim and 149 printed on front (singlet provided by the College), College PE shorts or navy blue running shorts (not available at The School Shop). CC sport/summer socks.

BASKETBALL – Boys: College basketball singlet and shorts by order only*.

Girls: College basketball singlet by order only*, with College PE sports shorts. CC sport/summer socks.

CRICKET – Boys: College cricket shirt, white cricket pants, CC sport/summer socks with College sports cap, sunsmart bucket hat and option of broad rim cricket hat. The cricket pants and hat are not available at The School Shop.

Girls: College PE polo shirt, PE sport shorts with CC sport/summer socks and College sports cap or sunsmart bucket hat.

FOOTBALL – Boys: College navy football shorts and football socks. Concordia match guernsey provided.

Girls: College football shorts and football socks. Concordia match guernsey provided.

HOCKEY – Boys & Girls: College hockey top by order only* with gold socks, to be worn with College PE shorts.

NETBALL – Girls Years 7-12: College netball dress by order only*. CC sport/summer socks.

SOCCER – Girls Years 7-12: College soccer top by order only*, with College PE shorts and gold socks.

Boys Years 7-12: College soccer top and soccer shorts by order only*, with College gold socks.

SOFTBALL – College PE uniform with College gold socks, and College sports cap or sunsmart hat.

TENNIS – Girls: College tennis skort, PE polo shirt and College sports cap or sunsmart hat. CC sport/summer socks.

Boys: College tennis shorts, PE polo shirt and College sports cap or sunsmart hat. CC sport/summer socks.

VOLLEYBALL – College PE polo shirt and College PE shorts. CC sport/summer socks.

**Orders for students needing specialised sports uniform must be placed via the on-line nomination form by due date in Term 1.*
