Music Scholarship

Music scholarships will be offered to new or current students in Years 7 to 12.

The scholarships provide remission of tuition fees based on ability, with instrumental bursaries available, for up to six years, depending on year of entry.

Successful candidates will be expected to make a significant contribution to a minimum of two co-curricular music groups on their auditioned instrument(s) and other music activities as determined by the Head of Music ELC -12.

Successful candidates will also be expected to undertake Music as a subject to the end of Year 12, and be involved in the Special Interest Music program from Year 7 or 8 (depending on year of entry) to 10.

Scholarships will be reviewed annually and are dependent on satisfactory progress reports, conduct and commitment to the co-curricular music program.

Applications close in January the year prior to commencement.

Results

Scholarship offers will be announced in the year prior to commencement. All applicants will be advised in due course of the outcome of their application.

Criteria for Award

This scholarship is awarded based on the criteria below:

- + Outstanding ability or potential on the student's chosen instruments
- + Sound application to academic studies
- + Positive involvement in music groups and activities
- + The student will not be in receipt of any other financial support from Concordia College

Application Procedure

Applications must be made online at www.concordia.sa.edu.au/enrolment/scholarships

To be considered for a scholarship, please ensure the following documents are supplied as part of the online application process:

- + A copy of the student's latest school report
- + Copies of music certificates
- + A written statement of no more than 200 words outlining the student's achievements in music

Shortlisted candidates will be invited to audition in February the year prior to commencement. Auditions will take approximately 30 minutes. Candidates will be required to:

- + perform two pieces of contrasting character
- + perform technical work
- + undertake sight reading and aural tests
- + present for an interview

Students will be required to provide their own accompanist. Parents are encouraged to attend the interview. Auditions will be held in the Music Centre at the Concordia Campus of Concordia College during school hours in February. When completing the application form, please indicate any times that you are unavailable for an audition.
