Otto Senior School Technology Scholarship 2026

Through the generous support of the Otto family, Concordia College offers a Senior School DTE (Design, Technology & Engineering) Scholarship for a new or continuing student in Years 10, 11 or 12 in 2026 who displays outstanding characteristics in a Technology related subject such as: Design, Technology & Engineering; Digital Technology. The successful applicant will be a student who has displayed genuine interest and ability in a Technology subject but also demonstrates qualities of involvement and commitment within their school and/or wider community.

The successful candidate will continue a Technology subject to the end of Year 12. This scholarship provides 25% remission of tuition fees and will be offered for the duration of the student's senior schooling at Concordia for a maximum of three years, until the completion of Year 12. Continuation of the scholarship is subject to regular review, with the recipient making good progress in the selected Technology subject and displaying conduct of a high standard.

Scholarship offers for 2026 will be announced in late **February 2025**. All applicants will be advised in due course of the outcome of their application.

Criteria for Award

This scholarship is awarded based on the criteria below:

- + Consistent performance and involvement in at least one Technology subject
- + A demonstrated ability in the chosen technology
- + Positive contribution within the student's current school and/or wider community
- + Outstanding personal qualities
- + Financial circumstances may also be taken into consideration
- + The student will not be in receipt of any other financial support from Concordia College

Shortlisted applicants may be required to attend an interview with the Head of College, Principal or School Leader.

Application Process

Applications must be made online at www.concordia.sa.edu.au/enrolment/scholarships

To be considered for a scholarship, please ensure the following documents are supplied as part of the online application process:

- + Copies of the student's school reports for 2024
- + A written statement of no more than 200 words which outlines the student's achievements in technology and how this scholarship to study a Technology subject will assist in their future career goals
- + Supporting evidence of interest, ability, involvement and achievement in Technology subjects, which may include:
 - Copies of technology awards or certificates of achievement
 - Photographs or samples of work / technology projects completed, either at school or home
- + Details of two referees, which may include the current school Principal, teachers, coaches or mentors

All details will remain confidential to the Concordia Scholarship Committee.
