### Application and Enrolment Fees

A \$75 non-refundable fee (\$100 for multiple siblings) is payable on application for admission to the College.

A non-refundable enrolment fee of:

- \* \$500 Enrolment Fee for ELC to Year 6

This enrolment fee is deducted from the first term tuition fees, Reception to Year 6.

### Family Concessions

A **sibling concession** on tuition fees applies for students attending Concordia Campus, St John's Campus (excluding ELC) and St Peters Campus (excluding ELC) at the same time.

- + 2nd child in family receives 10% off tuition fee
- + 3rd child in family receives 20% off tuition fee

### Composite Fee

This fee covers most curriculum requirements including school magazine, co-curricular activities and cost of year level camps, excursions, swimming and surf life saving.

At St Peters Campus payment is required for the cost of voluntary extra-curricular music tuition and Year 6 jackets.

### IT Levy

This fee includes the provision of a fully-serviced device, software and campus web access for the school year.

### Building Fund Contribution

The Building Fund Contribution is a voluntary fee of \$390 per family. This contribution assists in the maintenance of College buildings and facilities. If this is paid with fees upfront by January 1 2024, a 5% discount on tuition fees will be applied.

### Concordia Parents and Friends Membership

Included on the first term account is an annual charge of \$40 per family for membership of the Concordia Parents and Friends. This contribution enables the group to support community engagement and projects.

### Payment of Fees

Fees may be paid by the following methods:

1. Annually in advance, by 1 January with a 5% upfront discount including Building Fund Contribution
2. By 11 monthly direct debit/credit card instalments December – October.

Each family will be contacted by the College before January 1 to establish one of the two options above. Existing payment arrangements will be rolled forward.

Payment options can be found on the base of your Statement.

It is not College Policy to carry fees forward into the next billing year. Hence, fees under agreed payment plans with the College must be finalised by the end of October 2024.

The Concordia College Board reserves the right to terminate the schooling of a student whose fees are in arrears. The College also reserves the right to charge a late payment fee and the cost of recovery fees on overdue accounts.

Family accounts will not be split and will be billed as per the enrolment form. Where this represents a separated family, the College expects the enrolling parents/caregivers to arrange payment plans between themselves ensuring all fees are up to date.

When a student is to be withdrawn from the school, parents are required to give the Principal one school term's notice, in writing, before the withdrawal date, otherwise parents will be liable for an additional term's fees, in lieu of notice.

## Early Learning Centre (ELC)

### Cost per Student per day

- + The ELC is an approved Long Day Care Provider. Eligible families may access the Child Care Subsidy for ELC fees.
- + The ELC is open for 48 weeks a year, however attendance during term breaks is optional.
- + Bookings and accounts are managed through the online management system Fully Booked.
- + Fees are paid fortnightly by direct debit through Ezidebit.

### Term Breaks

- + Bookings can be made up until 6 pm on the day before care is required.
- + Cancellations can be made until 6pm on the day before care is required. Bookings cancelled after 6pm the day before care is required will incur the full fee.
- + Late fee of \$1 per minute for the first 10 minutes and \$5 per minute thereafter will apply after 6pm.

## Out Of School Hours Care (OSHC)

### Cost per Student per session

Before School Care

7.30 - 8.30am

\$15 permanent and \$17 casual booking

After School Care to 6.00pm

\$30 permanent and \$32 casual booking

Vacation Care

7.30am – 6.00pm

\$80 per day

Eligible families will receive Child care Subsidy.

Concordia OSHC use a Child Care Management System called Fully Booked to manage our bookings/accounts. This is a completely online system which gives parents the ability to easily manage all Before and After School, and Vacation Care bookings. Fully Booked in turn uses a simple debit system called Ezidebit to take payments.

- + A permanent booking is considered as any booking made 7 days, or more, prior to the required day of booking (ie. An ASC booking required for Tuesday would need to be made by close of business on the preceding Monday).
- + A casual booking, therefore, is considered as any booking made less than 7 days prior to day of the required booking.
- + A 7 day cancellation period will apply to all permanent bookings – all bookings not cancelled prior to 7 days will be charged as normal.
- + Late fee of \$1 per minute for the first 10 minutes and \$5 per minute thereafter will apply after 6pm.
- + Enrolment Fee of \$30 per child upon their enrolment into OSHC. This fee will cover the child for their entire primary school life.
