This session will immerse you in a compassionate way to think about behaviour and **'misbehaviour'** and to do this we use, 'soft eyes and warm hearts'. Our 'soft eyes and warm hearts' allow us to unlock what a child's behaviour is telling us because we want to dig deeper. A change in their behaviour begins in our heart. So, the next time your child, or any child says to you, *"who is the naughtiest kid you know?"* Your answer, "Every child's behaviour expresses an emotional need, and the adults must be clever enough to work out what the behaviour is asking and how to meet that need, gently and kindly." Our 'soft eyes' and 'warm hearts' mindset transports us from being annoyed by a child's behaviour and urgently correcting it, to imagining what is happening for them and how best to humanely meet the emotional need they are expressing.
